- **Independent Living Skills:** Learn real-world skills like budgeting, self-care, transportation, and everyday problem-solving so you can be more independent.
- **Advocacy:** Know your rights and learn how to speak up at school, work, and in your community.
- **Peer Support:** Connect with people who understand and can encourage you as you work toward your goals.
- **Information and Referral:** Need help getting started? We can connect you to programs, supports, and resources.
- **Transition Planning:** We help you, your family, your school, and GVRA plan for life after high school and what comes next.
- **More Support:** ADA compliance, assistive devices, home modifications, recreational activities, youth programs, and nursing home transition.

Free career services in partnership with Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency (GVRA), helping students with disabilities explore careers and prepare for the workforce before graduation.
