Our Divisions

- Vocational Rehabilitation (VR)
 Provides services for individuals with disabilities who want to work or maintain their current jobs.
- Roosevelt Warm Springs (RWS)/Cave Spring
 Offer academic support, job training, and career
 opportunities to students in a residential,
 college-like environment.
- Disability Adjudication Services (DAS)
 Processes claims and determines Social Security benefit eligibility for individuals who cannot work due to their disabilities.
- Business Enterprise Program (BEP)
 Helps visually-impaired Georgians become independent business owners in the food service industry.
- Georgia Industries for the Blind (GIB)
 Creates job opportunities for individuals who are blind or visually-impaired.
