# INCLUSIVE POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

The Inclusive Post-Secondary Education (IPSE) program offers students with disabilities opportunities to attend select colleges that offer Certified Transition Programs (CTP) that provide:

- Work Readiness
- Career Exploration
- Work Based Learning
- Self Advocacy Services

**GVRA provides**  
**\$3000** per semester towards the Certified Transition Program fees for up to 4 semesters

There is financial aid support available through Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Georgia Student Finance Commission for IPSE

## HOW TO GET STARTED

### 1. Research and Apply

Review the colleges that offers IPSE programs on [www.thinkcollege.net](http://www.thinkcollege.net) and apply to programs for which you qualify.

### 2. Get Accepted and Contact GVRA

After you are accepted into a CTP, contact GVRA to be connected to our IPSE representatives to coordinate with the college.

### 3. Start Learning!

GVRA will add the inclusive college program to the student's Individualized Plan for Employment (IPE) and assist with the transition from high school to college/university.
