What is Cave Spring Center (CSC)?

A residential rehabilitation center located in historic Cave Spring, Georgia, CSC is a program of Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency. It features a state of the art dormitory and classroom administration building. In addition to specialized services for the deaf and hard of hearing, CSC is an ideal option for individuals with disabilities in transition from high school who would benefit from vocational rehabilitation training and services provided on a small campus.

OUR PROGRAMS:

Deaf & Hard of Hearing Services

CSC staff are skilled in the use of Sign Language and experienced in providing training and education to individuals who are deaf and hard of hearing. The instructional staff also includes a certified deaf educator and special education teacher. CSC provides a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor to serve the Georgia School for the Deaf.

Employment Development Services

CSC provides training and preparation of individuals with disabilities for integrated, competitive employment. Students are provided an individualized program of study to increase skills and independence in activities of daily living and development of interpersonal skills.
