How Vocational Rehabilitation Works

Trained Certified Rehabilitation Counselors (CRCs) and other professionals work in teams to help eligible persons with disabilities prepare for, start, and maintain competitive employment, thus becoming tax-paying citizens in their communities.

How to Begin the Process

- Find your nearest local office online at gvs.ga.gov or by calling 1-844-FOR-GVRA or 1-(844)-367-4872.
- Call to schedule an assessment to determine your eligibility.
- If eligible for services, work with your team to develop an Individualized Plan for Employment (IPE).

Facts

- Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation Agency (GVRA) clients with job placements earn 24% more on average than minimum wage.
- **4,534** people were assisted in successfully finding employment during State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2017. That number exceeds the **3,979** served in SFY 2016 year by **555**.
